Submissions must be received electronically no later than 11:59 pm PST on May 3rd, 2024. Please review submission instructions carefully.

- quality of care
- health equity
- health policy
- implementation science

Submission Instructions

When preparing your abstract for submission, please follow the instructions below:

- Prepare abstracts in plain English text without embedded symbols or formatted characters. Spell out or translate symbols (beta, mean, chi-square, etc.) in your submission.
- Limit the abstract to 500 words NOT including the title, authors' names and affiliations, or funding information.
- If accepted, your abstract will be published in the program. Proofread your submission because edits will not be accepted after the deadline.
- You will also be asked to state whether you would like to be considered for a 15-minute oral presentation and/or poster presentation.
- We strongly encourage submitting your abstract earlier than the deadline.
